


#### MORAVIAN 69 REIGNING LEADER FOR SEVENTH YEAR IN A ROW

Moravian 69 remained in the leading position as the most popular barley variety planted in Wyoming since 2006. Moravian 69 was seeded on an estimated 26,700 acres. This variety accounted for 51 percent of malting variety seeding and 36 percent of Wyoming's total barley acreage. Haybet was the leading feed barley variety in Wyoming for the ninth year in a row. Haybet was seeded on an estimated 13,100 acres. This variety accounted for 58 percent of the feed variety and 18 percent of Wyoming's total barley acreage. Conrad was the second most popular malting variety for the seventh year in a row with 9,200 acres seeded, accounting for 18 percent of the malting barley and 12 percent of the State's total barley acres. Merit 57 was the third most popular malting variety with 4,200 acres seeded, accounting for 8 percent of the malting barley and 6 percent of the State's total barley acres. Xena was seeded on an estimated 3,200 acres. This variety accounted for 14 percent of the feed variety and 4 percent of Wyoming's total barley acreage.

Wyoming barley producers planted an estimated 75,000 acres to all barley varieties in 2012, unchanged from 2011. The Northwest District had 62 percent of the barley acreage in 2012, unchanged from last year. Malting varieties accounted for 52,500 acres or 70 percent of the total. Acreage planted to feed barley totaled 22,500 acres, 30 percent of Wyoming's total barley acreage.

The 2012 Barley Variety Survey was conducted throughout the month of June by the Wyoming Field Office of USDA NASS via phone and mail. The American Malting Barley Association, Inc. provided the funding for this survey. We would like to thank the Wyoming producers who voluntarily provided information for these estimates.








